FIELD KITCHENS

Our build team will be refurbishing several of wooden huts around the site to use as Field Kitchens.

They will be starting with Beechwood and then Lordfield, Ravenswood, Ash Grove and Woodside in that order and would hope to have all 5 of these completed by August.

Each Field Kitchen will save groups bringing marquees and other equipment - each will include an LPG gas hob, a worktop / serving counter and access to tables and benches.

In addition, those with mains electricity will have a fridge and those with running water will have a sink.

Pots, pans and kitchen utensils will be included in each and a full inventory will be added to the website shortly once the team have free access to the site (from 3 April) and can start work.
