| Slip, trips or falls  | Participants    | No running around building, only one climber on each wall at a time. Adult in charge to supervise. Participants should not climb, if possible, more than a foot of the ground. The aim is to get from one end to the other not climb the highest |   |
| Faulty Equipment  | Participants    | If equipment is found to be faulty or defective. Cease climbing and report to site staff   |   |
| Wet Weather   | All             | If climbing wall is to wet and the hand/foot grips are slippery the activity should not proceed.   |   |
